
Leather is a natural by-product

Modern leather manufacturing recycles over 270 million cow hides each year. These are a by-product of the food industry and without the ability of the leather industry to transform them into leather, over 7 million tonnes would go to landfill with huge environmental and biological impact. Leather makes a sustainable contribution to a society that needs to consume less, reuse more and a recycle everything.





The cattle are raised for the production of meat, milk and cheese. No cattle are raised for the production of leather, which is instead one of the byproducts of the food chain. By utilising the hides & extending the product life cycle, we elevate a material, which otherwise would become waste, by transforming it into a valuable product, long-lasting and sustainable. Both the farms and the slaughterhouses with which our partners collaborates are subjected to strict controls and must comply with legislation that regulates and defines rigid standards
